ADMINISTRATOR IN READING AWARD

The Arkansas Reading Association has presented the **Administrator in Reading Award** annually at the Fall conference since 1990. The purpose of this award is to recognize administrators in the State of Arkansas who have significantly contributed to the improvement of reading instruction and/or who have promoted lifetime reading habits.

To be eligible for this award, a person must be an administrator or supervisor in an Arkansas school district(s). An administrator or supervisor shall be defined as a school superintendent, assistant superintendent, principal, assistant principal, Title I supervisor or other administrative position.

A nomination for this award must be completed and signed by at least three (3) members of the International Reading Association who are also members of ARA and a local council. The application will be evaluated by a committee of ARA members according to the accompanying rubric. The chair shall be the Vice President of ARA.

Please include a photograph of the nominee and a signed statement giving permission to release this information for publication.
